

- •Ma'am, I have lost my shoes / blazer / Tiffin box / water bottled.
- Ma'am, I came late as I missed my bus.
- Ma'am, I'm sorry. I have forgotten to bring my book, note book, pencil / eraser /drawing booked.
- Ma'am, I'm sorry I couldn't complete my Home Work as I was unwell.
- Madam, may I borrow a pencil / eraser / ruler etc. from my partner as I've forgotten to bring it today.
- Wishing people properly Hello Uncle / Aunty how are you?
- Wishing parents and elders Good Morning, Good Afternoon, Good Evening and Good Night.

If we, as teachers and parents make a sincere effort and pay attention to the above mentioned points, we can help our children to learn, to understand and speak English at an early age.
